EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT: PROGRESS AND CHALLENGES IN SIOUXLAND

Recent data on educational attainment in Siouxland reveals progress in some areas while highlighting persistent disparities.

Among White, Non-Hispanic residents, the percentage without a high school diploma dropped from 8% to 5%, and those holding a college degree rose from 34% to 40%. Hispanic residents saw the most dramatic improvements, with those lacking a high school diploma decreasing from 55% to 43%, and college degree attainment increasing from 9% to 15%. However, among people of color (all ethnicities), the percentage without a high school diploma remained steady at around 29%-30%, and college degree attainment showed only modest growth, rising from 21% to 24%.

These trends suggest that while access to education is improving overall, significant gaps persist. The steady non-completion rate among people of color signals a need for targeted interventions to ensure equitable educational opportunities.
